

Read the following, then sign your agreement at the bottom of the page. Also go over the Code of Conduct with your children and have those who are able to sign the bottom as well. BY signing you are giving Tapestry of the Heart a guarantee that your family will adhere to this Code during all group activities.

Code of Conduct

- All children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all activities. If the parent is not present, the parent must have spoken with another attending adult and given disciplinary responsibility to that adult.
- Have respect for authority figures, whether that is the person in charge of a field trip, a tour guide, leader etc.
- Have an attitude of compassion of the differences, needs or disabilities of others.
- Act and Speak in a manner worthy of the God who calls you. NO unkind remarks, profanity, course jokes, conversations involving sensual situations or other language unbecoming of a Christian .
- Please dress modestly. No offensive clothing. (Good rule is: “If you don’t know if its appropriate don’t wear it.” If you have any question on what this might entail please ask a leader.)
- If you KNOW something may be offensive to someone else, please refrain from it.
- Respect the property and landscape of those we are visiting. If you break it you will replace it.
- Wholesome friendships are encouraged between boys and girls. HOWEVER, students should look upon one another as brothers and sisters in Christ and refrain from demonstrating overt personal affection.

Families who have difficulty meeting these requirements will be counseled by a member of the Tapestry Team or a Board member and repeated conduct problems will result in that family being restricted from attending any or all group activities.
